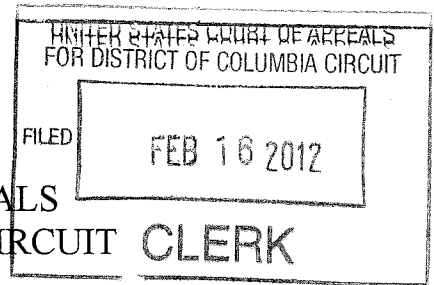


PETITION FOR REVIEW
